SCHEDULE & TEE TIMES:

Tuesday 8th July: Practice rounds & accommodation available.

Wednesday 9th July: Tee times scheduled from 10am (refer to published draw).
9 Hole Development Event presentation from 3pm (approx.).

Thursday 10th July: Thursday (Knockout rounds) matches will be a seeded draw released Wednesday evening after the conclusion of the qualifying round.

The Knockout rounds are scheduled as follows;

- First round matches (& any playoff) scheduled from 9am
- Quarter-final matches from 11am
- Semi-final matches from 1pm
- Super 6 Final match from 2.30pm
- Presentation 4pm (approx.)

After each Super 6 Knockout match, participants and family are encouraged to stay and watch the next round through to the Super 6 Final and presentation, however they are able to leave at their leisure. Live results will be available via Ratho Farm social media.

PRACTICE ROUNDS:

Monday 7th July: From 8:00am (roll up start – check in at Homestead)
Tuesday 8th July: From 8:00am (roll up start – check in at Homestead)

No cost for event participants, \$50 green fees for adults.

PRACTICE AREA:

There is no formal driving range at Ratho Farm Golf Links, however the following practice areas will be available for participants prior to Wednesday & Thursday's competition rounds;

- 18th green/putting green:** Players may practice on the 18th green prior to commencing their qualifying round (Wednesday).
- 18th fairway:** Players can use their own marked practice balls, or the supplied practice balls hitting back down the 18th fairway with irons only.

HIRE BUGGIES:

Limited pull buggies/trollys are available for hire for \$10 per day (no motorised carts). Participants are encouraged to bring their own.

COMPETITION RULES:

The gross scores of all players (boys & girls combined) from Wednesday 18 holes will qualify seeded for Thursday's Super 6 Knockout matches. All Super 6 participants will progress to Thursday play.

Both the 18 and 9 hole events will be governed by the Rules of Golf and *Tasmanian Junior Super 6 Competition Rules* in conjunction with the Local Rules of Ratho Farm Golf Links (supplied upon registration).

ACCOMMODATION & FACILITIES:

The accommodation at Ratho Farm consists of several old farm buildings lovingly restored into boutique rooms. Equipped with modern features but still retaining elements of the original masonry and carpentry, the result is a beautiful fusion of old and new. The clubhouse is the 'Homestead', which including breakfast room, lounge room, and 65 person capacity glass atrium.

NEARBY ATTRACTIONS:

Bothwell (popn.~400) is situated in the Clyde River Valley and the southern gateway to the Central Highlands. The historic town has over 50 buildings of historic and architectural interest and is one of the most important heritage towns in Tasmania.

Bothwell attractions include;

- Australasian Golf Museum, from 11am to 3pm daily (\$5 entry).
- Local walks including Mt Adelaide.
