



# TERMS OF COMPETITION

## 1. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- 1.1 The *Tasmanian Junior Super 6* ("Super 6") will be played as stroke play qualifying over 18 holes at Ratho Farm Golf Links on Wednesday 15 July, 2026, then 6 hole matchplay matches on Thursday 16 July, 2026.
- 1.2 The *9 Hole Development Event* ("9 Hole Event") will be played as stroke play over 9 holes on Wednesday 15 July, 2026.
- 1.3 The top 16 gross scores (boys & girls combined) from Wednesday qualifying round will qualify for Thursday's Super 6 Knockout matches.
- 1.4 In the case of a tie for the 16th place, unless the Event Committee determines otherwise, a 6-hole playoff over such holes as the Event Committee decide will determine which competitor advances to the Super 6 next round.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Eligible to enter the event are amateur golfers who are under the age of 18 as at Wednesday 15 July, 2026. Special consideration will be made for competitors over the age of 18 as of this date if there are less entrants than the capacity of the event as of the close of entries.

## 3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$135 for the Super 6 or \$45 for the 9 Hole Event (inc. GST) is to be paid to Ratho Farm ("the Venue") by the close of entries (unless otherwise agreed by the Event Committee).
- 3.2 Entries shall be made via email to [crainey@pgamember.org.au](mailto:crainey@pgamember.org.au) or [events@rathofarm.com](mailto:events@rathofarm.com) or by post to PO Box 1, Bothwell Tasmania, 7030.
- 3.3 The Event Committee has the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3.4 Entries must be received by the Event Committee by 5.00pm Friday 10 July, 2026.
- 3.5 The field for the Super 6 will be limited to 32 players. In the event of entries exceeding the number of available places available, a ballot will be undertaken based on the decision of the Event Committee.
- 3.6 Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur.
- 3.7 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Event Committee.
- 3.8 The Event Committee has the right to withdraw any person from the event at any time for COVID-19 related reasons.
- 3.9 The tournament draw will be available at [www.rathofarm.com](http://www.rathofarm.com) and sent to entrants approximately four days before the event.

## 4. TROPHIES

- 4.1 Trophies will be awarded for the following:
  - Tasmanian Junior Super 6 Winner and runner up
  - 9 Hole Development Event Winner and runner up

## 5. EVENT COMMITTEE

- 5.1 The Event Committee will be formed by personnel associated with Ratho Farm.
- 5.2 In the absence of a full Event Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Event Committee.
- 5.3 The Event Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the terms.
- 5.4. The Event Committee's decision on matters affecting the tournament will be final.

## 6. REFUND POLICY

Any entrant may withdraw up to the time of the close of entries (3.4) and have the entrance fee refunded. Refunds after that time will be at the discretion of the Event Committee.

## 7. RULES OF GOLF

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, and any supplementary local rules as determined by the Event Committee, will apply. The event will be governed by the Rules of Golf and Tasmanian Junior Super 6 Competition Rules in conjunction with the Local Rules of Ratho Farm Golf Links (supplied upon registration).

## 8. CADDIES

Caddies are permitted during this event. Caddies, whether they be parents, other family members or friends, are reminded to avoid placing unnecessary pressure on the competitors. No advice should be given to a competitor by a caddie unless requested, nor should a caddie criticise the decisions or efforts of a competitor at any stage of the event. The Event Committee reserve the right to withdraw the caddie rights of any person who they believe is not acting in the best interests of the competitor or the ideals of Ratho Farm.

## 9. SUSPENSION OF PLAY (RULE 5.7)

The following signals will be used to suspend and resume play:

- Immediate stop for imminent danger – one prolonged note of a siren.
- Stop for a non-dangerous situation – three consecutive notes of a siren.
- Resumption of play – two consecutive notes of a siren
- Note: When play is stopped for imminent danger, all practice areas will be immediately closed.

## 10. IMAGES

Ratho Farm and/or the Event Committee ("the Organisers") may arrange for promotion of the tournament, for radio, internet and television broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of the tournament or excerpts thereof in any and all media throughout the world, whether now known or hereafter developed.

By this application, the player consents to the use by the Organisers, or persons authorised by the Organisers, of their name, likeness, voice and references to them and photographs and other images of them and their play connected with their appearance in the tournament, or any portion(s) thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of the tournament. The Organisers may utilise the rights granted it hereunder in connection with the promotion of this tournament as well as other associated events.

The cooperation of players with authorised representatives of the media is required, provided that no pre-event activities outside of those activities which are part of the event will be required and provided that the player's tournament play is not unreasonably interfered with.
